### **Committee Reports:**

Fundraising: given by Helda Martin

- Boosterthon Fun Run Sponsors: Milstead (check received), Woodforest (waiting on check) and Spring Modern Dental (waiting on check); \$500 sponsorship will put Sponsor on all paperwork, \$750 to be put on marquee; Top 3 Teachers whose classes raise the most will get massages; Top teacher will get one Painting with a Twist; Checking with Target to see if we can get gift cards; Top Grade Level child gets a gift card to the movies; Will do Dancing with a Fly again if we get donations from all 50 states; Teacher incentive if all 50 states have donations, possibly a jean day, pajama day, will brainstorm more ideas; Mrs. Oliver will get slimed if we hit \$50k; Fourth Grade Color run, see if Boosterthon will come down in prices, We will not announce it to the kids yet, and will come back to it
- Spirit Nights- Kendra Scott, Friday, January 20, 2017 (they will create flyer for us), Last year we raised \$611; Jerry Built, January 26<sup>th</sup>, to include all beverages; Crust Pizza, November 8, 2016, to include all beverages; Chick Fil A- October 25, 2016 from 4:30-7:30, families need to mention Kaufman
- Skate Night- Raised \$549; Mrs. Vatland's class won most in attendance; Discussed doing glow stick incentives for first 100 children (Helda to price out glow sticks); Can we do rewards for top class in each grade level, possible popsicles (Helda will look at past winners and email board), Discussion Tabled
- Painting With a Twist- We can do it at the school or at Painting with a Twist; If we do it at Painting With a Twist, must be prepaid, maximum 60 people, cost would be \$35/person for 2 hour class or \$40/person for 3 hour class; If we do it at Kaufman, they have a minimum of 20 people, must be prepaid, they provide all materials, cost would be \$35/person for 2 hour class or \$40/person for 3 hour class; Kaufman would receive 20%; Discussed doing the first one there to see how it goes, Possibly set for February.
